Committee	Descriptions
Adirondack Wool and Arts Committee	Responsible for the planning and executing the Adirondack Wool and Arts Festival.
Advertising Committee	Responsible for making recommendations to the board pertaining to the successful promotion and advertising of the Washington County Fair.
Ag Center Committee	Responsible for the planning of the entertainment and activities happening in the Ag Center during the Washington County Fair.
After Fair Celebration	Responsible for the planning of the the After Fair celebration.
Audit Committee	Responsible when called upon to participate in the annual audit with our outside auditing firm.
Big Push Committee	Responsible for the planning and executing of The Big Push event at the Washington County Fair.
Budget Committee	Responsible for developing a yearly balanced budget for the management of the corporation and the operation of the Fairgrounds
Buildings and Grounds Committee	Responsible for familiarize yourselves with all buildings and areas of the fairgrounds to enable you to make recommendations and accurate assessments of building repair and upkeep
Bylaws Committee	Responsible for reviewing the bylaws of the Washington County Fair Corporation periodically, or at the request of the Fair Board of Directors
Camper Committee	Responsible for providing support and execution of campers at the Washington County Fair
Cattle Committee	Responsible for advising, making suggestions for policy surrounding cattle classes and award changes
Concessions Committee	Responsible reviewing applications and selecting participants for the Washington County Fair. Including making recommendations for vendor fees, percentage, footage that is paid to the fair.
Convention/Anniversary Committee	Responsible for the planning and organizing of celebrations pertaining to the Washington County Fairgrounds. To work closely with the Fair Managers to plan the portion of the convention that is required by the State Fair Association in conjunction to any office held by the manager or member of the Washington County Fair Board of Directors
County Bounty/Community Living Committee	Responsible to assist with the planning of exhibits in the County Bounty and Community Living buildings
Draft Animal Committee	Responsible for the planning and educating the public by setting up and maintaining educational exhibits throughout the Washington County Fair
Entertainment/Scheduling Committee	Responsible for the selection, booking and scheduling for the Entertainment at the Washington County Fair
Equine Committee	Responsible for advising, making suggestions for policy surrounding cattle classes and award changes
Failbook Committee	Responsible for proofreading all the Exhibitors Handbook insure that all changes are correct and that all information is current and accurate
Fair Store Committee	Responsible for selecting what merchandise should be offered at the Fair Store

History/Museum Committee	Responsible for making recommendations for the preservation, beautification, and educational uses of the museum complex. To compile all available historical information both visual and printed.
Junior Committee	Members are youth ages 14-21 to work together to learn how Washington County Fair comes together each year. To help prepare them to become future leaders and decision makers of the Washington County Fair. The group will be guided by members of the fair association and friends of the fair
Motorsports Committee	Responsible for the all the rules and regulations governing the operation of all the motor sports events and their participants. To make recommendations to the Board of Directors for the approval of any additions or changes are deemed to be in the best interest of the fair, the safety of the participants and spectators and important for the operation and promotion of motor sports events.
Policy Committee	Responsible to research and develop current policies procedure, resolutions, etc of Washington County Fair, Inc. To blend viable old policy and current policy into useable form for our Corporation. While doing this, we need to adhere to the plan of consolidation and Bylaws of the Corporation.
Rodeo Committee	Responsible to work closely with the team management and organizers for Rodeo night at the Fair
Safety Committee	Responsible for the drafting rules & regulations governing the safety of all employees, volunteers, exhibitors, concessionaires and fair patrons on the fair property.
Scholarship Committee	Responsible for reviewing candidates and recommending a criteria for scholarship applicants
Small Animals Committee	Responsible for working with the team to determine the needs and make recommendations to the fairboard for the small animal departments
Sunshine Committee	Responsible for expressing grief or happiness in times of sorrow or joy to employees or members of the Corporation or their families
Traffic Control/Parking Lot Committee	Responsible for working closely with the traffic team to determine the needs for moving people during the fair in the parking lots and within the fairgrounds
