  - EMAILED OR ONLINE ENTRIES will receive an invoice from the Washington County Fair office. This invoice MUST be paid by 4pm on Friday July 18th.
  - Late and Day-of-show entries will be accepted at \$20.00 per doe.
  - NO REFUNDS. Substitutions are permitted within breed.
- The base date for computing age is the day of the show July 20th, 2025.
